As an important milestone in 2021, the Task Force on Indices supported the Ziraat Asset Management in Türkiye for the establishment of a fund based on the S&P/OIC COMCEC 50 Shariah Index, which was launched in 2012. In line with the relevant resolutions of the COMCEC Ministerial Sessions, the Fund enables investors to invest in Shariah-compliant shares in OIC capital markets through a single product.

Published by the OICEF Secretariat with the valuable contributions of our Members and public resources, annual OICEF Statistics Report serves as a valuable source of aggregated and consolidated information on OIC markets. The report also includes the analysis of the data in comparison with global markets as well as key statistics on Islamic capital markets.

I would like to thank all members who made the preparation of this report possible by providing data through the annual survey. We hope that the report will be instrumental in enhancing our knowledge base on OIC markets.

ABOUT THE ORGANISATION, THE COMMITTEE AND THE FORUM

The Organisation of Islamic Cooperation¹

The Organisation of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) is an inter-governmental organization that represents the Muslim world with 57 Member States and endeavors to safeguard their interests in the spirit of promoting international peace and harmony. It was established upon a decision of the historical summit in Rabat on 25 September 1969, following the criminal arson of Al-Aqsa Mosque in occupied Jerusalem.

Among the OIC's key bodies: the Islamic Summit, the Council of Foreign Ministers (CFM), the General Secretariat, in addition to the Al-Quds Committee and three permanent committees concerned with science and technology, economy and trade, and information and culture. There are also specialized organs under the banner of the OIC including the Islamic Development Bank and the Islamic Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization, as well as subsidiary and affiliate organs that play a vital role in boosting cooperation in various fields among the OIC member states.

Standing Committee for Economic and Commercial Cooperation of the Organisation of Islamic Cooperation²

The Standing Committee for Economic and Commercial Cooperation of the Organisation of the Islamic Cooperation (COMCEC) was established by the Third Islamic Summit Conference of OIC in 1981. Chaired by the President of the Republic of Türkiye, it is the main multilateral economic and commercial cooperation platform of the Islamic world, which convenes annually at ministerial level in istanbul.

Some of its objectives are to address the economic challenges of the Islamic Ummah, to contribute to the development efforts of the Member States, to draw up programs and submit proposals designed to increase the welfare of the Member States, and to ensure the overall coordination of the activities of the OIC relating to economic and commercial cooperation among the Member States.

The Organisation of Islamic Cooperation Exchanges Forum³

Established consequently to the 20th Session of the COMCEC in 2005, The Organisation of Islamic Cooperation Exchanges Forum (OICEF) provides a dedicated, centralized and cultivating platform for 44 national and 2 regional stock exchanges, 13 commodity exchanges, and 22 central securities depositories (CSDs) (Members) in 48 out of 57 OIC Member States (Annex I). OICEF serves as a communication channel within a collaborative framework for the representatives of Members and relevant OIC organizations and institutions—enabling cooperation among shareholders in developing Islamic capital markets and strengthening their relationships.

As the Secretariat of OICEF (Secretariat), Borsa İstanbul has been hosting annual Meetings, leading the Task Forces, and publishing annual Statistics Report (Report) and quarterly Newsletter with the contribution of Members. Annual Meetings set the stage for briefing on activities, sharing experiences, discussing ideas on challenges and opportunities. Task Forces undertake long-term projects, currently

focusing on precious metal, indices and sustainability—through which Members collaborate to develop long-term and fruitful relationships. The Report and the Newsletters serve as valuable sources of aggregated and consolidated information for Members.

ABOUT THE SURVEY AND THE REPORT

The Report presents individual and aggregate capital markets data for Members. The data is primarily provided by the Members who participate in the annual Survey. In order to extend the representation of the Report to a meaningful level, additional public data regarding Members who have not participated in the survey is collected from their official websites and World Federation of Exchanges (WFE) Statistics Portal. Report also includes analysis of data in comparison with global markets as well as key statistics on Islamic capital markets.

The survey for the exchanges focuses on key figures about the capital market products available for trading at the Member Exchange categorized in asset classes. The section on Sharia-compliant securities in the exchange survey captures the organized Islamic capital markets data—which is not easily accessible. The format of the survey has been standardized where the terms and definitions have been adopted from the definitions of the international exchange federations. The glossary of terms, along with the previous reports, is published at oicexchanges.org for reference.

The patterns, trends, and other results presented in this Report are based on the datasets of 17 stock exchanges, which are referred as "OIC Stock Exchanges" collectively. 12 of the 17 OIC Stock Exchanges have responded to the Survey (Annex II) while the data for the rest were sourced from WFE. Members whose data for certain categories could not be obtained from the available sources are excluded from the relative calculations.



Benchmark indices of the OIC Stock Exchanges in USD weighted by market capitalization had a 19% annual increase in 2021. The rate of change was -2.5% for the MSCI Emerging Markets Index, 21.8% for the MSCI World Index, and 18.5% for the MSCI All Country World Index.



Number of Listed Companies

There were 4,465 companies listed at the OIC Stock Exchanges with a 6% annual decrease. The ratios for BM and IDX constituted 38% of the number of listed companies.




Market Capitalization

OIC Stock Exchanges have represented \$6.46 trillion of the world equities markets at the end of 2021—which is 5.2% of WFE Members' market capitalization—with a 8% annual increase in the market capitalization, while that of the WFE Members was \$123.75 trillion with a 17% annual increase.




The ratio of the total market capitalizations to the total GDP values of the relative Member States was 112% for the end of 2021.




Number of New Companies

There have been 226 IPOs and other offerings in 2021 with a 29% annual increase in all offerings.




Funds Raised from Public Offerings

Funds raised from public offerings were \$24.8 billion in 2021 with an 81% annual increase.



Value of Trading

OIC Stock Exchanges had \$2.49 trillion of traded value for equities in 2021 with a 8% annual decrease, which was 1.5% of the WFE Members' value. Top 5 exchanges accounted for 87% of the traded value.



Securitized Derivatives

5 out of 17 OIC Stock Exchanges had 2,914 securitized derivatives available for trading at the end of 2021 with a 34% annual increase, whose trading value was \$6.5 billion with a 53% annual decrease.

Exchange Traded Funds (ETFs)

11 out of 17 OIC Stock Exchanges had 181 ETF products at the end of 2021 with a 20% annual increase, whose trading value was \$105.4 billion with an 80% annual increase.


Investment Funds

9 out of 17 OIC Stock Exchanges had 618 investment funds available for trading in 2021 with a 7% annual increase, whose trading value was \$82.1 billion of trading value with a 0.4% annual increase.


DEBT INSTRUMENTS

The outstanding value of debt instruments listed at the OIC Stock Exchanges was \$505.1 billion with a 17% annual decrease in 2021. The value of trading for the 3,513 instruments was \$1.12 trillion with a 13% annual increase.









Outstanding values of the instruments are displayed below:



Domestic public instruments account for most of the volume; foreign instruments are relatively illiquid.







Domestic Public Instruments

The value of 1,515 domestic public debt instruments was \$464.7 billion at the end of 2021 with a 18% annual decrease. The value of trading was \$1071.5 billion with a 18% annual increase.

Domestic Private Instruments

The value of 1,875 domestic private debt instruments was \$40.4 billion at the end of 2021 with a 9% annual decrease. The value of trading was \$43.5 billion with a 43% annual decrease.

Foreign Instruments

Borsa İstanbul, Baku Stock Exchange, and Kazakhstan Stock Exchange had 123 foreign debt instruments at the end of 2021, valued \$75.7 million with an 8% annual decrease. The value of trading was \$577.0 million with a 125% annual increase.

REPO Market

The total REPO trading value at Borsa İstanbul and Baku Stock Exchange was \$1.63 trillion with a 39% annual decrease in 2021.

DERIVATIVES

Borsa İstanbul, Bursa Malaysia, Dubai Financial Market, Iran Fara Bourse and Tehran Stock Exchange had a total of 4.9 billion derivatives contracts traded in 2021 with a 170% annual increase. The types of listed contracts at these exchanges are plotted below:

Stock Futures

Borsa İstanbul, Bursa Malaysia, Dubai Financial Market, and Tehran Stock Exchange have stock futures available for trading. Borsa İstanbul, Bursa Malaysia, and Dubai Financial Market had trading volume of 1.7 billion contracts in 2021 with a 46% annual increase.

Stock Index Futures

Borsa İstanbul, Bursa Malaysia, and Tehran Stock Exchange have stock index futures available for trading with a trading volume of 97.8 million contracts in 2021 with a 7% annual decrease.

Interest Rate Futures

Borsa İstanbul and Bursa Malaysia have interest rate futures contracts available for trading with a trading volume of 147 contracts in 2021 with a 69% annual decrease.

Currency Futures

Borsa İstanbul had 96.2 million contracts traded 2021 with a 53% annual increase.

Commodity Futures

Borsa İstanbul and Bursa Malaysia have commodity futures available for trading with 150.7 million contracts traded in 2021 with a 13% annual decrease.

Stock Options

Borsa İstanbul, Iran Fara Bourse and Tehran Stock Exchange have stock options available for trading with 2.8 billion contracts traded in 2021 with an 891% annual increase.

Stock Index Options

Borsa İstanbul and Bursa Malaysia have stock index options available with 421,772 contracts traded in 2021 with a 17% annual increase.

Interest Rate Options

Bursa Malaysia and Iran Fara Bourse have interest rate options with no trading in 2021.

Currency Options

Borsa İstanbul was the only OIC exchange that has currency options available for trading with 748,351 contracts traded in 2021 with a 22% annual decrease.

Commodity Options

Bursa Malaysia was the only OIC exchange that had commodity options available for trading with 95,205 contracts traded in 2021 with a 50% annual increase.

OTHER PRODUCTS

Borsa İstanbul has spot commodities available for trading; trading value of gold was \$18.3 billion with a 59% annual decrease, trading value of silver was \$657.1 million with an 8% annual increase, and trading value of platinum and palladium was \$2.6 million with a %100 annual increase in 2021.

SHARIA-COMPLIANT SECURITIES

According to Islamic Financial Services Board's (IFSB's) Islamic Financial Services Industry (IFSI) Stability Report, the Islamic financial industry has grown to \$2.7 trillion in 2020 with an 11% annual increase. The share of Islamic capital markets was 31% with \$833.3 billion of value and a 27% annual growth.

In terms of Sharia-compliant securities available for trading, based on the responses from 5 OIC Stock Exchanges, there are 380 sukuk products (a 13% annual increase) with the outstanding value of \$79.0 billion (an 18% annual increase) and trading value of \$21.1 billion (a 30% annual increase) in 2021. The number of Sharia-compliant shares are 1,913 in 2021 with a 6% annual increase. There are also 51 Sharia-compliant funds including ETFs and REITs with a 6% annual decrease.
